


Latin America






Export Agricultural product from LATAM 2006 - 2010




Amount of importing polymer in Peru from 2006 - 2010




Import agricultural from USA to Peru





2009 Growth of Mining production in Chile



Chile HDPE to pipe Demand in 2009 Thailand paid 6% import duty while Korea 0 duty




Total HDPE Consumption



Colombia and Peru Total demand supply for Pipe 4118 MT and 9210 MT in 2009 respectively




Colombia Total HDPE Consumption




